God is working in BOTH our oneness and our uniqueness to mature us and grow us

Ephesians 4:7-16

Have you ever stopped and pondered that our personal maturity (or immaturity) impacts the rest of the body of Christ?

Uniquely United for Maturity



Ephesians 4:7 Any gift we've received is completely an act of God's grace and based entirely upon Christ

God's equipped us for the task He has in store for us

Ephesians 4:7-8

Verse 8 quotes Psalm 68

Our King (Jesus) has won the battle (He's triumphed over death, sin, and hell) but He DOESN'T hoard the rewards Ephesians 4:9-10

Jesus ascending is universally accepted as Jesus (after His time on earth) going to the right hand of the Father

I tend to look at this passage similar to Philippians 2:5-11

Philippians 2:5-8



Jesus was in Heaven, but He emptied and humbled Himself and took on flesh and descended to earth (entire purpose was to set the captives free) Philippians 2:9-11

When I read Ephesians 4:9-10, I see Jesus descending into earth to rescue mankind and with that accomplished, Jesus has ascended back into Heaven. to be glorified forever

The point of this bunny trail... we ought to stand back and marvel at Jesus' generosity and the power and the authority that He has

Ephesians 4:11-14 Christ has given some specific gifts (of leadership) and these gifts should be used to help mature believers

Ephesians 2:19-22 Ephesians 3:1-5

Apostles and Prophets were foundation (the Lord used them to reveal His Truth and usher in the church)

"Evangelists" = heralds; messengers; the spreaders of Good News

These flocks need shepherds (pastors), who can help instruct and guide them spiritually in God's Word I Peter 5:1-4

In order to NOT be "tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine" sheep NEED to be taught; Ephesians 4:14-16

Through our oneness IN Christ and our uniqueness (that sets us apart for Christ) we are to mature!!!

When differences arise (and they will) how we respond is equally as important to the offense in question
