SUBBANDER

Believers have an all-access pass to God, through Jesus. Our Heavenly Father is available to listen (any time) and He desires to hear any request (great or small)

Matthew 7:7-8

Ask, seek, knock – these are 3 commands, with 3 distinct and precious promises attached (ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and it will be opened)



Matthew 7:7a

Prayer bridges the gap between our inability and God's inexhaustible ability

Our Heavenly Father is able completely capable and willing to hear us and answer our prayer requests

Prayer is TOO vital for us to postpone until later

Sometimes our prayers AREN'T answered because they AREN'T offered (we've never vocalized them to God)

And sometimes our prayers AREN'T answered because they are asked with a wrong motive

Am I soaking up ALL that God has for me to learn?

When we ASK, we come to God through prayer and we verbalize our requests

Matthew 7:7b

Matthew 6:32-33



"Seek" = to pursue after; to crave; to desire with thoughts

This type of craving begins in the mind. It's in the thought life, LONG before it takes root in our actions

Philippians 4:8-9



SEEKING is a mental pursuit, which dwells on God

Matthew 7:7c

Persistently plead (pinpointedly pray over) and passionately present our prayers to our Heavenly Father (knock and knock)

Knocking depicts a physical component (there needs to be an active piece, where our prayers are faith driven)

Matthew 7:8



Jesus gives 3 commands (ask; seek; knock)

Those commands are present active commands, which means they are continual

It basically means keep asking, keep seeking, and keep knocking (DON'T stop... do it now and do it next)
