SUBBANDER

Wolves are vicious and ravenous and seek to destroy

Acts 20:28-38

Paul urges those in Ephesus to be on the look out for these types of false teachers

Matthew 10:1-12

Wolves are sneaky and cunning (when they attack it's normally in packs — they are ruthless and aggressive)

Matthew 7:15-20



"Beware" = (present, active Greek verb) ... devote your thought and effort to this truth DON'T do it once, keep devoting yourself



Jesus' teaching goes from the path of destruction to specifically teachers of destruction (false prophets – wolves in sheep's clothing) Matthew 7:13-14

Seek out tried and tested fundamental Biblically minded and Gospel-centered scholars ALL of us NEED to be careful about who we are listening to and learning from

Matthew 7:16-20

Nearly EVERY New Testament book addresses False Teachers or False Teaching in some capacity

How do we detect these wolves in sheep's clothing?

Good teaching comes from good prophets

I Timothy 3:1-7

This individual is evaluated and examined based upon the fruit that his life displays

Three Helpful Tests to Identify Good Fruit:

1 – The Doctrinal Test

Evaluate what is being taught by the unwavering truth of the Gospel of Jesus Christ

2 – The Pendulum Test

Evaluate what is being taught by the extremes being presented

3 – The Practical Test

Simply observe the teacher's life (What's their character?)

Eventually these wolves in sheep's clothing will be held accountable
