Genesis 5:18-24 Enoch's lifespan was significantly shorter than his ancestors (Enoch only walked on this earth for 365 years)

God, seeing Enoch's faith, rewarded Enoch 64 NOT allowing him to taste death (God miraculously took him)

Hebrews 11:5-6 Enoch recognized the error of pursuing to live life apart from God and he decided to cling to God and walk with Him through faith wills crasy

"Taken up" = put in another place; to be transferred (in this particular case from earth to Heaven) 11 Kings 2:9-12a H3 GERI

The Hebrew phrase "Taken up" is also used of a burnt offering, which rises up in smoke to Heaven

Mile & Green

Enoch was pleasing to God and without faith it is impossible to please God, we must believe in God and surrender to Him

COME & CREET

there's an implied continual growth attached to this process (Enoch Must have had sweet fellowship with God)

Matthew 16:24-27

Wild & Green

If anyone desires to come after god (to follow Him) it requires us to be in submission to His leading

Colle & Grazy

Enoch understood the reality that 64 following God, the world would reject him, however, he faithfully walked with God and desired God's affection more than the world's eres
