yet, 64 faith, Moses rejected that and identified with his native people (the lowly and despised - Hebrew slaves)

The parallels to Jesus are striking: 1. Both were born when the hing ordered every Hebrew 6a64 604 under the age of 2 years old to be killed MIG & GREET

- 2. BOTH Were desiverers
- 3. BOTH left royalty to serve
- 4. Both serve as mediator (a bridge between God and man)

#### 5. BOTH Were opposed by the people they came to deliver
