The outside world is watching and they have an idea of what an authentic Christian should behave like

Over and over again in this letter, we see the idea that real genuine and authentic faith is practically lived outit's visible

This letter (James) is written to a group of believers who have been dispersed (scattered) abroad because of persecution

James 1:1 James 2:26



Authentic faith has to be accompanied by works (or actions.) What we do reveals what we have faith in.

James 1:1a
Who is James?

Tradition points to him being one of Jesus' half-brothers

Matthew 13:53-58

The people of Nazareth (where Jesus was from) were astonished at how wise Jesus was and the miraculous things Jesus did

Instead of this curiosity drawing the people of Nazareth toward Jesus, it actually caused them to be offended (they resented Jesus)

This was how the people in Jesus' childhood home saw Him. And it probably impacted the way Jesus' half-brothers viewed Him too John 7:1-9

Theologians almost unanimously agree that during Jesus' entire life, His half-brothers NEVER believed Him.

This begs the question "What changed?"

I Corinthians 5:3-8



Seeing Jesus alive AFTER being crucified, that reality changed James (James now believed that Jesus was who He ALWAYS claimed to be-the Messiah)

I Corinthians 15:3-4

Luke 16:27-28

Luke 16:29-31



It's easy to get discouraged in ministry when you give of yourself and it seems to only fall on deaf ears- DON'T STOP Focus on those who hunger and thirst after Jesus

James goes from denying and rejecting that Jesus is the Messiah to a devoted church leader

The main thrust of this letter has an emphasis on doing, but it comes from a heart fully surrendered - one that had been radically impacted by a personal relationship with Jesus
