James 1:21 Hebrews 12:1-3



SAME Greek word translated "Putting aside" and "Lay aside"



In order to run this race well and NOT be encumbered, we MUST entirely remove **ALL filthiness and the** weights of sin **James 1:22**

It's NOT enough to ONLY hear or read God's Word

Put into practice what you profess to believe

James 1:23-24



"Looks" = it's careful observation (very familiar with his reflection)



This person knows what God is expecting him to do, any failure to follow is NOT because of a lack of understanding

The purpose of knowing God's Word is to apply it and live it



Intently scrutinizing Scripture and putting action steps to what we've learned every interaction is a chance for application **James 1:25**

There are FOUR reasons why this person, who is a hearer and a doer, is blessed in what he does



I. HE LOOKS INTENTLY AT GOD'S TRUTH

"Looks intently" = (More than just observing, it speaks to a person's posture) – they're stooping down to stare and study

John 20:1-5

In James the person looking intently at the Perfect Law (God's Word) is stooped over and zealously searching the Scriptures

II. HE CONTINUES TO ABIDE BY IT

James 1:25a



"Abides" = to remain beside; to continue ALWAYS near (it carries with it an idea of permanency in forever perpetuity) Psalm 1:1-8

III. HE DOESN'T FORGET WHAT HE'S HEARD

James 1:25a



Look at God's Word, study it intently, continually reside in it, and never ever forget it (Proverbs 7:1-3)



IV. HE PUTS THE TRUTH INTO PRACTICE

James 1:25



The culmination of hearing and absorbing and NOT forgetting is to put ALL that truth into practice!
