If you think you're religious but live with an uncontrolled tongue, your religion is worthless



ACCEPTABLE RELIGION

James 1:26

"Religious" = one who fears God and desires to worship Him

In this passage, James gives us 3 qualities that should be visible in the lives of ALL authentic followers of Jesus Christ

I. WHAT WE COMMUNICATE MATTERS

"Bridle" = what the person on horseback uses to lead, direct and guide the horse

Luke 6:45 If our speech is NOT guarded (under full control) then it indicates a **concerning disconnect James 3:7-12**

ALL of our communication needs to be under control... (if we're NOT controlling our tongues, we are deceiving ourselves)

II. HOW WE SACRIFICIALLY LOVE THOSE WHO ARE VULNERABLE

James 1:27



True, genuine, authentic religion (based on Christ) is one that cares for other people

Followers of Christ went out of their way to NOT just meet the needs of their own vulnerable and needy, they actually sought to actively meet the needs of any and ALL vulnerable and needy

"Visit" = move to; step toward; to get involved with



This verse is saying believers need to move toward and get involved with those who are vulnerable and needy

James 1:27



III. HOW DO WE REMAIN HOLY WHILE WE MINISTER TO **OTHERS Holiness (or separation from** the world) is required as we are sent out into the world to share Jesus Christ
