## FLAMIN'HOT TONGUES

### **James 3:1-5a**



## The tongue is incredibly dangerous and we need to recognized how much we **MUST depend on the Holy Spirit for help James 3:5b**

In many other languages, a flame is often referred to as a tongue (because it resembles a tongue as it flickers and dances) The real emphasis is NOT on the visual similarities, but on the uncontrolled and destructive nature of both)

If the tongue is NOT controlled, then it will have a negative component (that DOESN'T stay isolated it spreads

2 questions, which stop gossip from spreading: 1 – Have you already told this piece of information to the source? 2 – How does telling me this piece of information help the situation?

# ALL it takes is one careless statement and a life is ruined

## Matthew 15:11, 18-20

### James 3:6

This seems to magnify the devolving negative spread (it doesn't stay isolated -**ALL aspects of our lives** get scorched)

## The tongue, which started the fire, is in the end, punished by fire (if NOT controlled)

### **James 3:7-8**

### "Tame" = to subdue, to bring under control



The tongue compared or contrasted with 4 illustrations:

- 1 Tiny bit in a horse's mouth
- 2 Little rudder on a large ship
- 3 Small spark, which sets the whole forest ablaze
- 4 Taming the tongue
