John 14:1

This is a command  
(it can be translated  
“**Stop being troubled**”)



Jesus wasn't the **source** of  
the trouble that the disciples  
were about to face



Unless Jesus laid His life  
down as a ransom for **MANY**,  
then there was **NEVER** going  
to be hope for **ANY**

John 14:1-4





DON'T be confused, Jesus  
is **NOT presently** preparing  
a place for us, His finished  
work on the cross **already**  
did that



Jesus' disciples **knew** the Way,  
they **interacted** with the Way;  
**watch** Him preach; and saw  
confirmation in His miracles

John 14:5-6



If there are **alternate** routes to heaven, then it means Jesus death and resurrection was **inadequate** and WASN'T enough

John 14:7-14



To know Jesus, was the **SAME**  
as knowing God the Father



That SAME type of **trust** and  
**reliance**, Jesus encourages  
His disciples to **mirror** and  
**embrace**, through the  
finished work of Christ
