What do our hearts reveal about the authority and sufficiency of the Word of God?

Are we listening and hearing God's Word and are we applying it?



God uses His Word to refine us, teach us, correct us, encourage us, equip us, and challenge us

James 4:5-6a



God resides inside of ALL believers and God expects **ALL** believers to humbly surrender and follow Him in obedience

God "Gives" = which means God bestows; He passes or transfers ownership (This is constantly ongoing)

James 4:6a



"Greater" = MORE remarkable in magnitude, degree and effectiveness

James 4:6b



"Opposed" = a military term, which depicts a vivid image of an army spreading out before a common foe



Pride puffs us up and in our arrogance, we wrongly diminish how much we desperately need God and our pride can also cause others to be led astray

"Humble" = NOT rising far from the ground
