HUMBLE YOURSELF

If you want to STOP the self-centered tendencies which wage war internally and spill into other relationships, then submit yourself to God

James 4:7a

The proper response is to submit; to surrender your will and your desires and to obediently follow what God has for you

We begin by asking the questions: "What does God want from me? Where does God want me to serve Him?"

The ONLY way to correct our selfish, prideful hearts is to submit to God (to die to yourself and live for Christ)



Do you see the order: It's glorify God (1st) and when you do, you will enjoy Him forever (our pleasure comes from glorifying God)

James 4:7 Matthew 4:1-11



EVERY aspect of Jesus' life was lived in complete submission to His Heavenly Father

James 4:8a



Resist the devil (put off that destructive relationship) and instead draw near (put on that desirable relationship)

"Draw Near to God" = to come near; to approach; to be joined together



James 4:8

If you genuinely desire to draw near to God, then your actions and your thoughts should reflect that profession

BEFORE it's too late; before you're entangled and ensnared by sin, STOP and cleanse your hands

James 4:9



This is the 4th call to repentance (let your heart break over sin; turn from your wicked, idolatrous ways, you double-minded)

James 4:10

Being humble means to have a proper view of oneself; to understand our desperate need and to seek God's help

"Exalt you" = to be lifted up (ONLY God is able to take the broken and humbled in heart and restore them)
