As we approach James 4:11-12, the unity we share with other believers needs to be front and center

James 4:11-12



ONLY ONE LAWGIVER AND JUDGE

Matthew 7:1-5

There's a drastic difference between lovingly confronting someone and sitting in a place where you cast judgement on someone

Before we seek to assist another believer with a potential sin issue, we must evaluate our own hearts

James 4:11



"Do not speak against" = literally means – to speak down or against (this is someone looking to damage or destroy someone's reputation

Speaking ill of a brother or sister in Christ disregards the precious bond which we both share through Christ

When James says, "Speak against the Law and judges the Law," what he means is "they are applying the Law and it's NOT their place"

Before we share something about someone else – ask 2 questions:

- 1. Have I already shared this with the person it's about?
- 2. How does my sharing this help that person or situation?

None of us are perfect, we are all equally accountable to God for what we participate in and how we daily live

James 4:11-12



When we attempt to act as the Lawgiver and Judge, we elevate ourselves and deny the authority, which we are all subject

Romans 8:1-4

Ephesians 2:8-10



Pride has NO place and it's prideful to sit on God's judgement seat, we have NO right to execute judgment on anyone

James 4:11-12

"Judge" = one who makes decisions based upon examination and evaluation
