



Luke 17:11-19

Luke 17:11

This area between Galilee and Samaria was a region where halfbreeds lived (half Jew and half Gentile) the Jewish people wanted nothing to do with Samaritans



Luke 17:12-13

In Jesus' time, leprosy was considered incurable and anyone who was diagnosed with leprosy was shunned from society



Leviticus 13:45-46

Jesus sees their trouble and Jesus steps into their trauma



Luke 17:14

Only the priest in Jesus' time could declare a person healed from leprosy and no longer unclean

As they were traveling, at some point while they were on their way to the priest, after obeying Jesus, they were healed Luke 17:15-16



All 10 lepers realized they had been healed, but only one came back to glorify and show honor to Jesus for miraculously healing him



This grateful leper was a Samaritan (the same people who the Jews detested and thought of as dogs)

Luke 17:17-19



Sometimes God's own people tend to be the slowest to give God the gratitude
