Luke 17:11

This area between **Galilee** and **Samaria** was a region where half-breeds lived (half Jew and half Gentile) the **Jewish** people wanted nothing to do with **Samaritans**





Luke 17:12-13

In Jesus' time, leprosy was considered **incurable** and anyone who was diagnosed with leprosy was **shunned** from society





Leviticus 13:45-46

Jesus **sees** their trouble and
Jesus **steps into** their trauma





Luke 17:14

Only the priest in Jesus' time could declare a person **healed** from leprosy and no longer **unclean**





As they were **traveling**,
at some point while they were
on their way to the priest,
after obeying Jesus,
they were healed

Luke 17:15-16





All 10 lepers realized they had been healed, but only **one came back** to glorify and show honor to Jesus for miraculously **healing him**





This **grateful leper** was a Samaritan (the same people who the Jews detested and thought of as dogs)

Luke 17:17-19





Sometimes God's own people
tend to be the **slowest** to give
God the gratitude
