# All of us NEED to be intentionally involved in one another's lives

### The Greek verb "Confession" is looking through the lens of God's perspective when it comes to sin



# "Confession" is written in plural, which means it's widespread, beyond a single individual

**Gaining information as to** what someone is presently struggling with should heighten and intensify our prayers for that person

#### Commit to praying for one another – it's a sign of genuine Christlike, agape love – we pray because we truly care

#### **These "effective prayers"** are persistent prayers (prayers filled with energy) these are empowered energy filled prayers Philippians 2:12-13 James 5:17-18

# In the Greek it literally reads, "with prayer he prayed" Elijah's prayers were persistent and this persistence is what led to it NOT raining for 3 years and 6 months

The God, who answered Elijah's persistent prayer is the SAME God, who is actively at work inside of ALL believers

James 5:19-20

"Strays" = includes both deliberate and willful leaving, as well as, passively deceived into leaving The emphasis is now that you've gone astray, how do we effectively and fervently restore a believer to Christ?
