people will STILL reject and deny Him

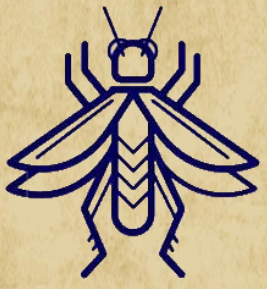
Revelation 19:11-21

to the clear instruction of God

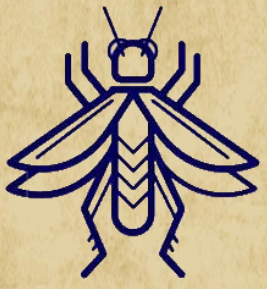
Joel 3:9-16
