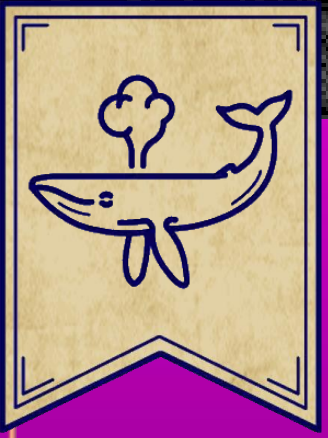

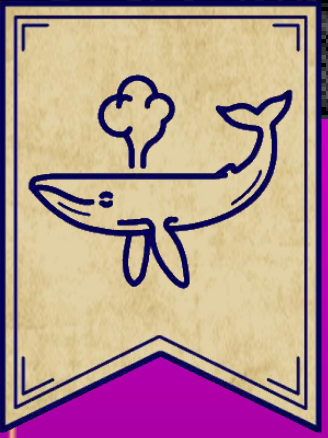

Jonah: The Fish Fiasco

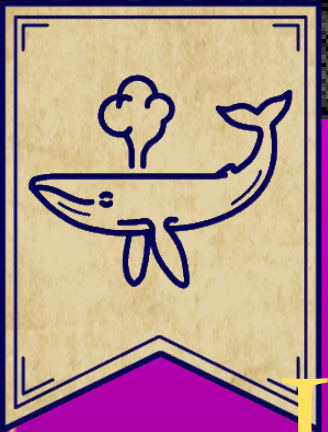




Jonah 1:17

Jonah's lack of obedience is in stark contrast to the giant fish's complete obedience

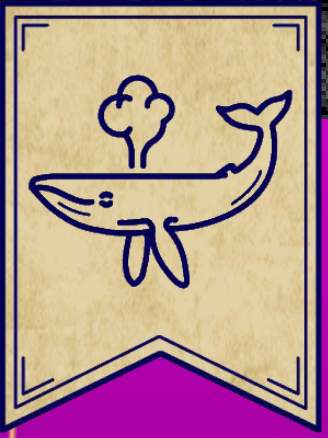




It takes Jonah 3 days and 3 nights

comes to his senses

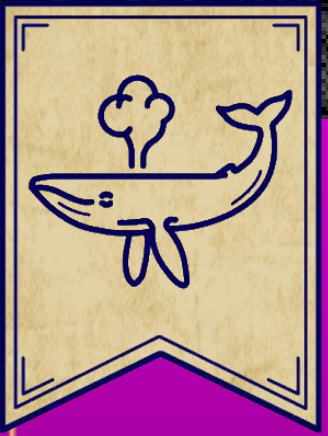
Jonah 2:1





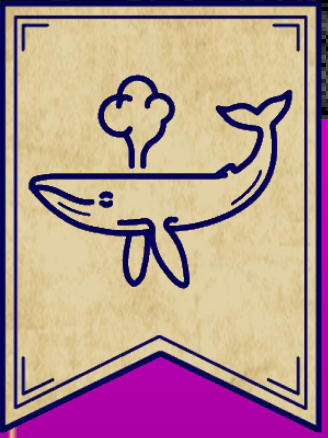
God is **ALWAYS** available and

he could have made



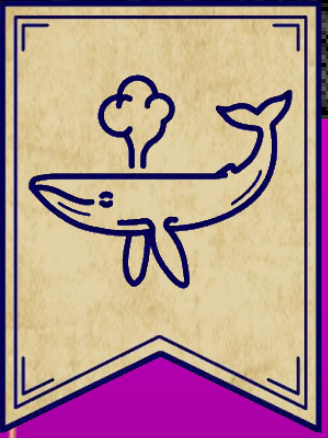

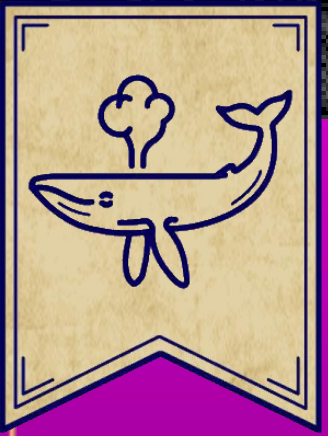




What unfolded was **NOT ONLY**

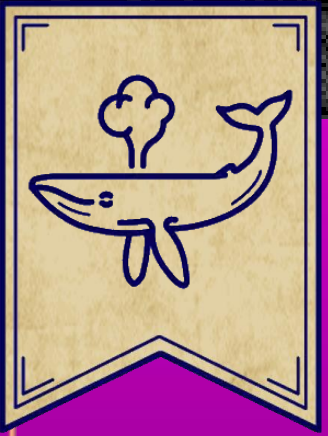


Running from God

(resisting God's instruction)

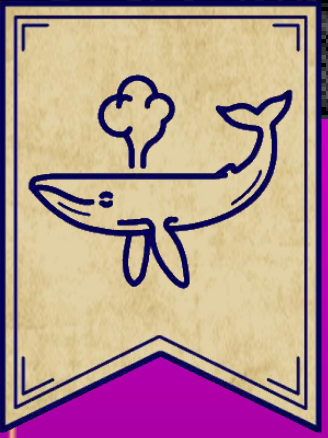
is NO different than the heart behind

God's discipline had humbled Jonah and brought him to the place where he was once again useful in God's hands

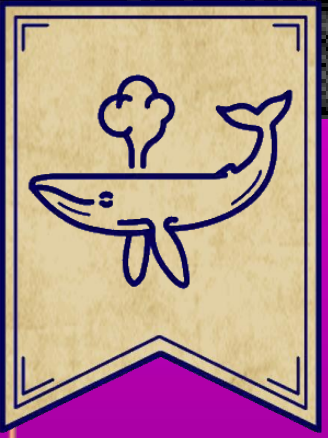




Humble yourself **BEFORE**

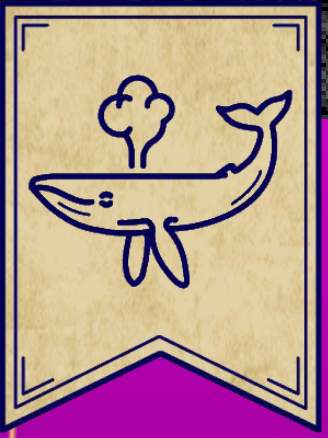




Salvation is offered freely
