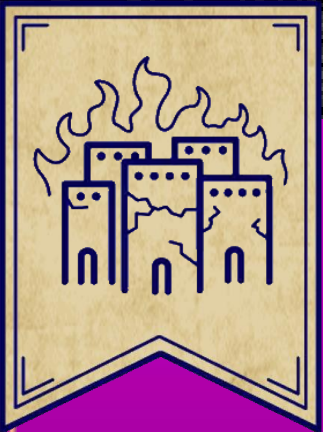

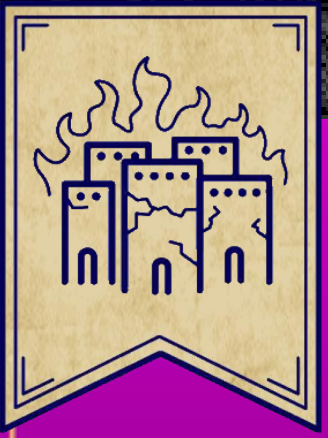

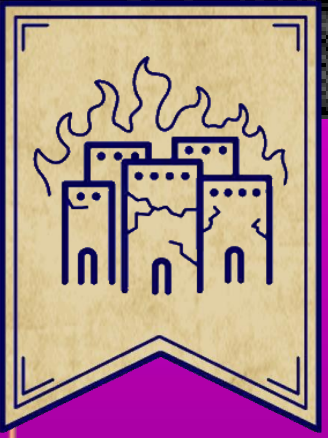




Genesis 6 – the World-Wide Flood

to build the ark)

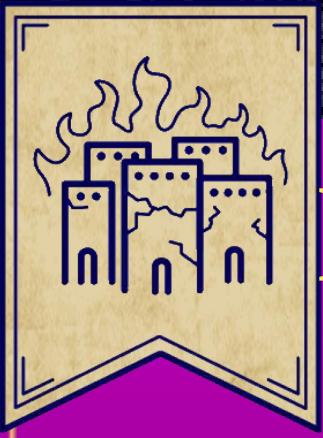




Numbers 13 – the Wilderness Wanderings

is jaw dropping

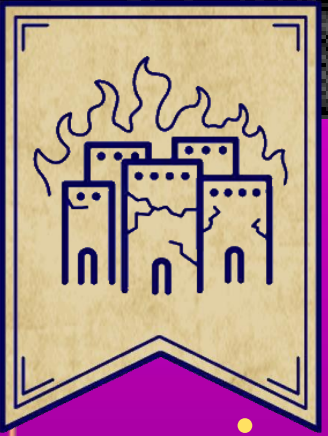




II Kings 17 – the Assyrian Captivity

of denying and defying God





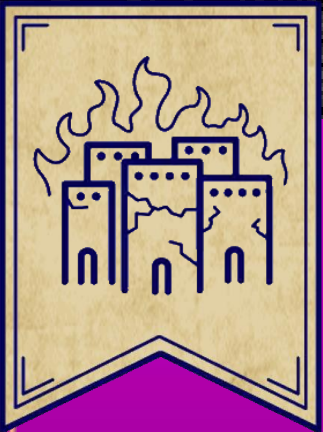
Understanding and trusting

Nahum: God Knows

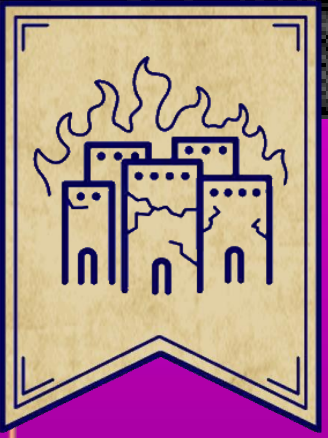




Psalm 139:1-6

sense of living in a broken world



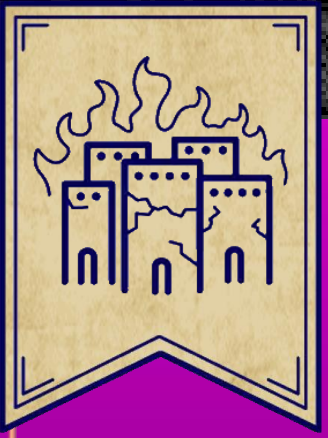


Nahum 1:1-5

Our God is jealous

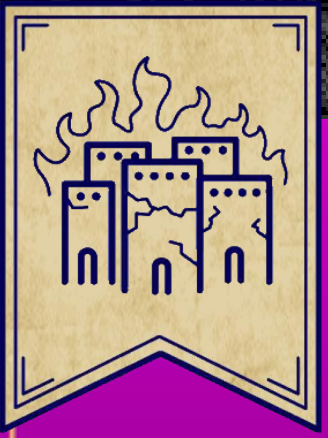
(He alone is worthy of ALL

God sometimes waits to execute judgment because He is extending the opportunity for those enemies to turn to Him

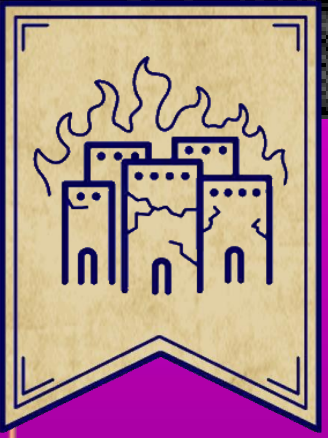




Our God will NOT leave
