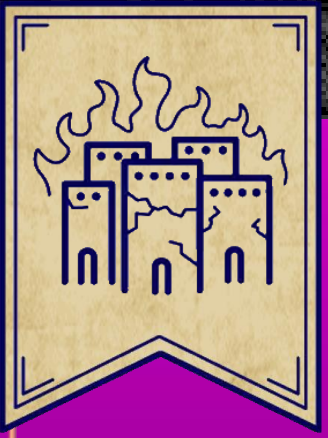


# Messengers: Nahum

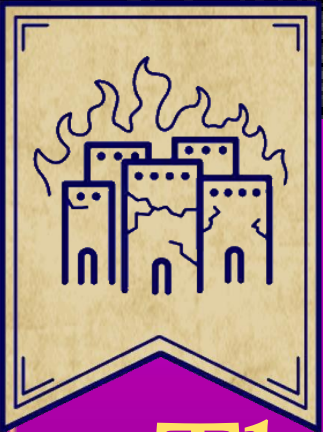




## Nahum 1:1-15

This prophecy of future destruction of the people of Nineveh occurs roughly 100 years after Jonah's message of repentance



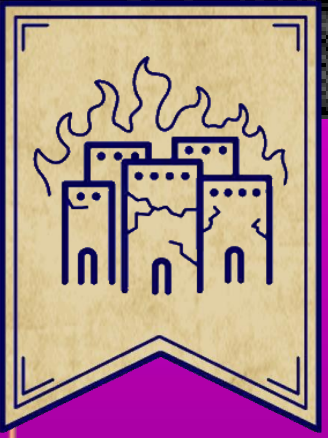


## II Kings 17:1-5

## II Chronicles 28:22-25

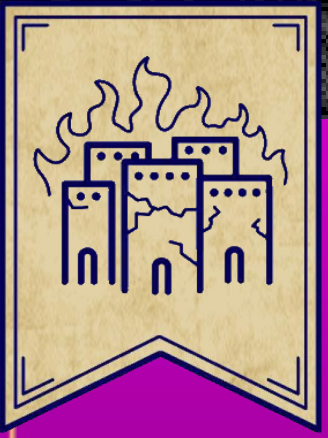
In the middle of what was an incredibly dark time history, God relentlessly pursued (His people) those in Judah

# Nahum: Judah: Humbled and Praying

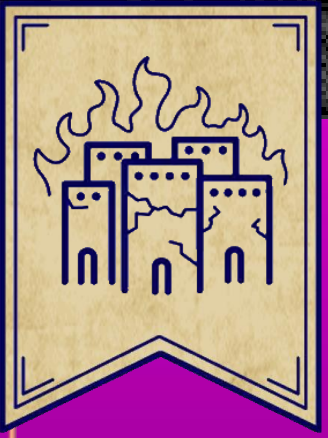

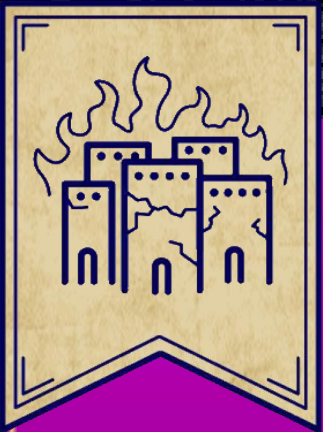

(according to the Book of Joshua)



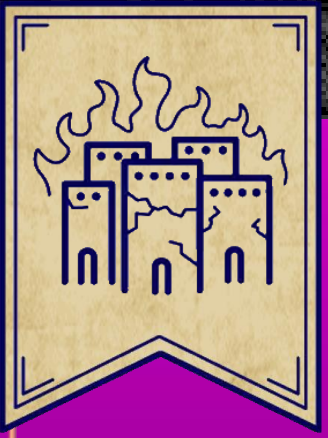




The revival went through ALL

change if we're NOT willing

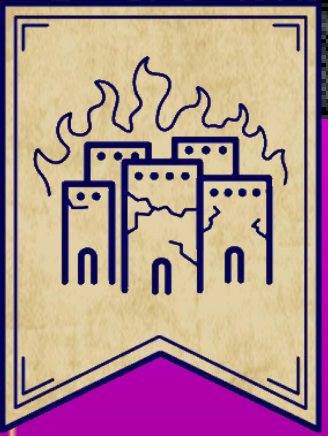




## II Kings 22:3-13
