## Nahum 3:1-19


Nineveh (the capital of Assyria) was NOT ONLY going to be soundly defeated and destroyed, they were going to be humiliated






#### Nahum 3:1


Great mourning would befall the bloody city of Nineveh – they caused much bloodshed and they will experience the same

The Assyrian Empire appeared to be an invincible foe, they had overwhelmed the entire region from the Nile to the Tigris






# NO amount of protection or fortification was going to stand against the power of Almighty God


Nahum 3:5-7

Nineveh's devasting fall will be well known – their humiliation and shame will be on full display for ALL to see




Nahum 3:8-10
