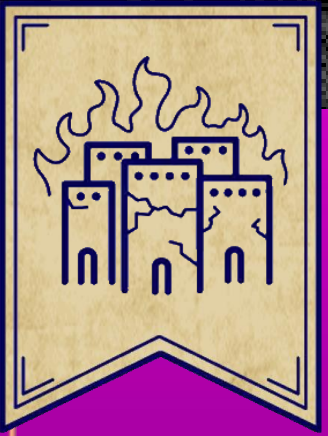

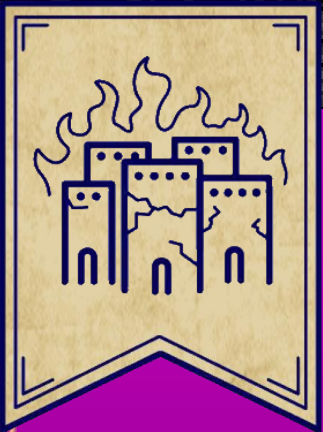




Psalm 94:1-7

sometimes unknown to us





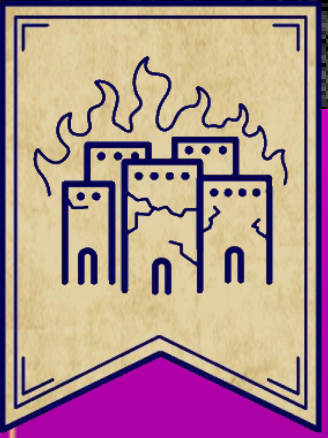
Nahum 3:1-19

Nahum: Game Over

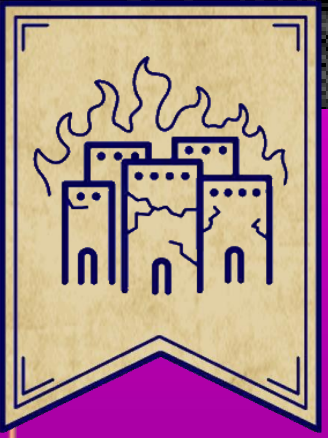




Nahum 3:1

Great mourning would befall the bloody city of Nineveh – they caused much bloodshed and they will experience the same

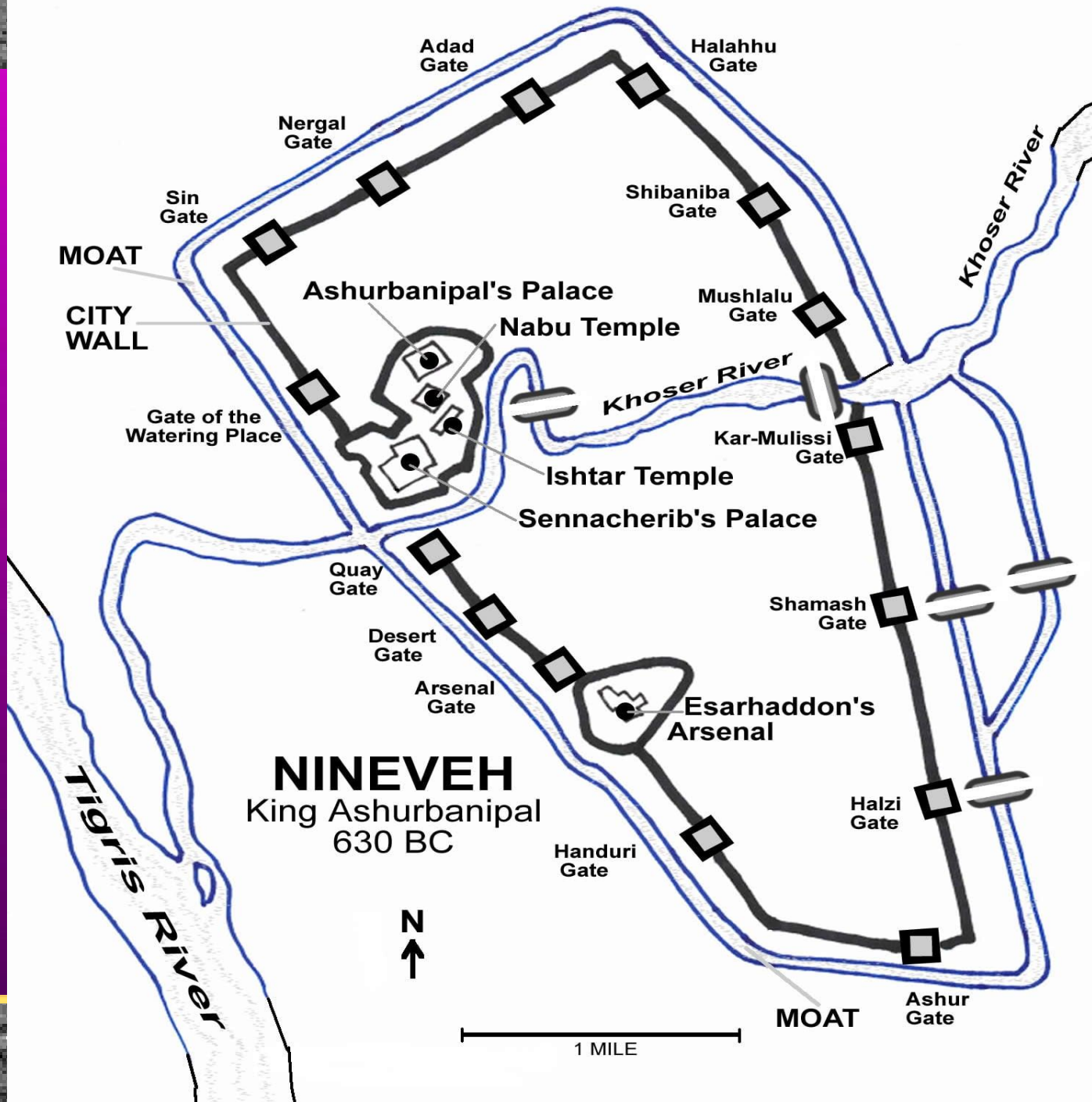


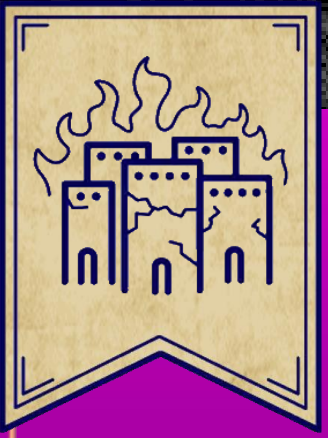


Nahum 3:2-4

The Assyrian Empire appeared to be an invincible foe, they had overwhelmed the entire region from the Nile to the Tigris



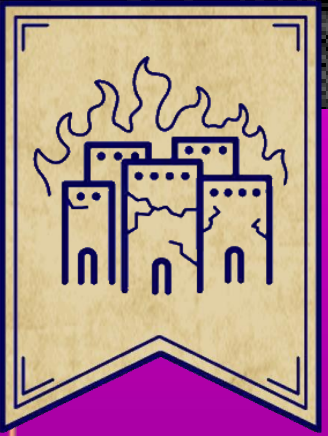




NO amount of protection or fortification was going to stand against the power of Almighty God

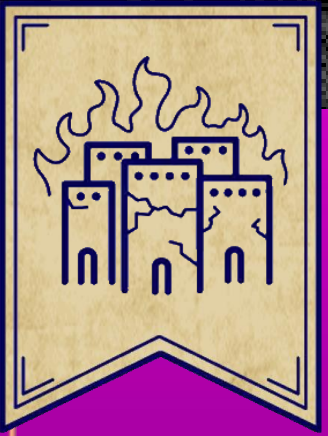
Nahum 3:5-7





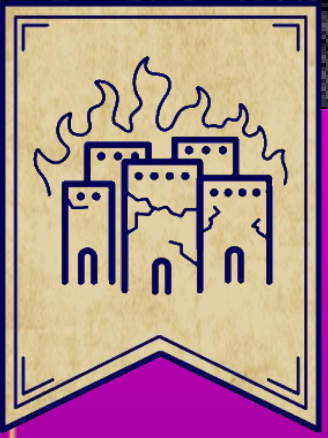
“Behold, I am against you” =

Nineveh's devastating fall will be well known – their humiliation and shame will be on full display for *ALL* to see



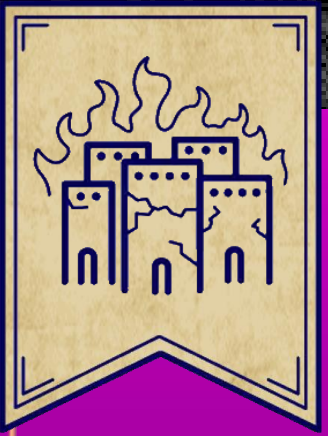


Nahum 3:8-10
