


If our thinking contradicts and doesn't align with Scripture, we need to adjust and alter our thoughts

Amos 1:1-2



God was about to communicate some hard to hear truths, through an unlikely prophet from the Southern Kingdom

The self-existent God, regardless of anyone's acknowledgement is Sovereignly Supreme and over EVERY nation and people

Amos: Israel Is Targeted





God saw EVERY sin and now judgment was coming





Syria was going to be judged for their cruelty and brutality

Amos 1:6-8

The Philistines were guilty of selling the Israelites into slavery

Amos 1:9-10



The Phoenicians were guilty of breaking their covenant of brotherhood (made between Hiram and King David)

Amos 1:11-12

The descendants of Esau showed no compassion toward and hated their brother (Israel), judgement was coming for this blood related enemy Amos 1:13-15

The Ammonites disregarded innocent and vulnerable human lives all at the expense of expanding their territory

Amos 2:1-3

Moab killed Edom's king and then desecrated his remains by taking the king's bones and burning them

Amos 2:4-5

Judah's offense = God gave them the Law and they didn't keep God's commandments (in practice, they despised it) James 4:17 Amos 2:6-8

The only truth any of us should stand upon is the unfailing and unflawed Word of God ("Thus says the Lord")

Amos 2:9-16
