judgment was coming

The Philistines were guilty of

The Phoenicians were guilty of breaking their covenant of brotherhood (made between Hiram and King David)

The descendants of Esau
showed no compassion toward
and hated their brother (Israel),
judgement was coming for this
blood related enemy

The Ammonites disregarded innocent and vulnerable human lives all at the expense of expanding their territory

then desecrated his remains by taking
the king's bones and burning them
