Amos: Fermenting Fruit





Amos 8:1-3

This fruit was at the end of the harvest
God is indicating that the Northern
Kingdom of Israel had
come to the end of the line





“Silence” = a devastating hush,
where NO tongue will speak
because of the widespread loss
of loved ones before them

Amos 8:4-6





“Hear This” = diligently listen;
pay close attention; give heed;
hear with the intent to obey

“Trample” = to crush;
to devour; to swallow up





There WASN'T a time where the
rich WEREN'T greedily pondering
how to cheat their customers out of
MORE money

The rich people exploited the poor
SO BADLY that the poor were forced
to sell themselves into slavery
