“Covenants” = promises or agreements
and acted as a binding contract
between two parties





BOTH of the covenants given to
Abraham and David
were unconditional –
they were guaranteed by the
unfailing character of God





Israel had broken the covenant
given to Moses



Amos: From Ruin to Restored





Amos 9:1-4

“Standing” = to station oneself
(it speaks of a posture of firmness and
determination) God was setting
Himself against their altar





“Sheol” = this is NOT talking
of hell (it’s actually best translated
to mean either the grave or
the place of the dead)

The One who used to protect them
will now punish them





Since Israel **DIDN'T** keep
their end of the covenant with Moses,
ALL they held near and dear
was going to be **ruined**

Amos 9:5-6





Even the Promised Land,
which flowed with milk and honey,
would cease being a rich
agricultural resource

Amos 9:7-10





It is quite shocking and attention grabbing, when God calls Israel, His chosen display people, “The Sinful Kingdom”

Amos 9:11-12





In the future,
once the Messiah returns to rule,
there will be forgiveness and restoration





The **SAME** One who is behind
the coming judgment by the Assyrians
ALSO administers this restoration

Amos 9:13-15





God made other covenants,
which were unconditional

1. The Covenant to Abraham –
the entire world would be blessed
through the family tree of Abraham





2. The Covenant to David –
there would be a king, who would sit
on the throne and rule FOREVER

3. The Covenant to Noah –
God will NEVER again flood
the earth with water
