All aspects of the Hebrew people's existence was to point people to the One True God (God was the Source of their success)

John 3:16-18





God makes this display nation a promise
(contingent upon 2 distinct aspects)

1 – They were to stay loyal to the
One True God

2 – They were to express that loyalty
by following His clearly
communicated commands





Instead of following God's commands,
BOTH Israel and Judah rejected
God's covenant





Micah: Covenant Rejected: Lying, Lusting and Larceny





Micah 2:1-2

“Woe” = an expression of lament;
associated with deep suffering
and mourning





Israel and Judah were inventors
of all kinds of evil

(when they laid their head on the pillow
at night, they devised evil plans)





“Seize” = they took by force or they
tore away by violence





They didn't care if it hurt someone else or even left them for dead; they just cared about self

Micah 2:3-5





What they coveted would now
be coveted by another and it would
be forcefully taken, like they had
originally taken it

Micah 2:6-11





While the Abrahamic Covenant
was NOT nullified by their
disobedience, that DIDN'T mean
discipline was to be neglected

Micah 2:12-13





Our eternal hope does NOT
depend on our ability to obey
(our hope is firmly attached to
God's glorious grace)
