Christmas resent

Biblically speaking, we can learn MUCH from the names of people and places recorded in Scripture



The name Jesus is a declaration of the mission God sent Him on

"Angel" = messenger or one who is sent with a specific message

Joseph was afraid of taking Mary to be his wife

John 6:41-42

This angel assures Joseph that his concern of being shamed, while understood, was unneccessary

esus: Name-Above sallames

Matthew 1:18-19 Joseph was compassionate (clearly, he cared about Mary and despite the hurt and betrayal he felt, he wanted good for Mary)

Joseph's eyes were refocused and realigned to God's bigger picture and bigger plan

Matthew 1:20

"Joseph" = the Hebrew name is related to the idea of "taking away" and in its place "God shall add"

God was taking away Joseph's shame and in its place, God was going to add the fulfillment of His incredible promise



"Jesus" = the Lord saves (this name encapsulates ALL of the Old Testament promises of God sending a Savior, Deliverer, Redeemer, etc)

Matthew 1:21

"Save" = rescue, but it also contains another nuance, it means to protect, to keep alive, to preserve life
