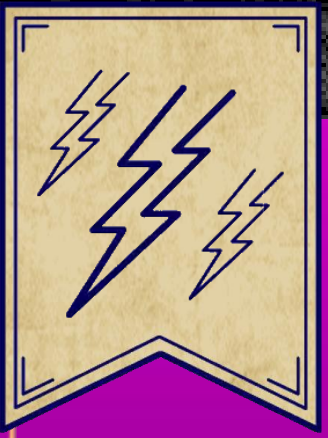

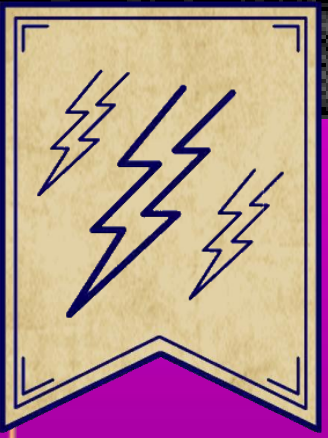




## Genesis 6:5-8

of man's choice to rebel

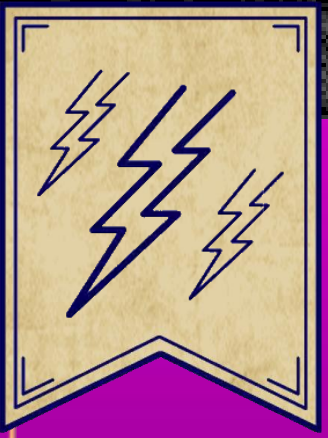




## Genesis 2:5-6

“The Day of the Lord”

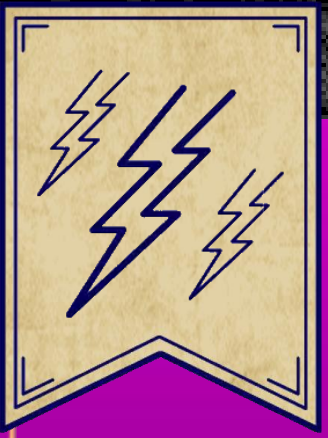






# Zephaniah: Christ: Our Shelter In The Day Of The Lord

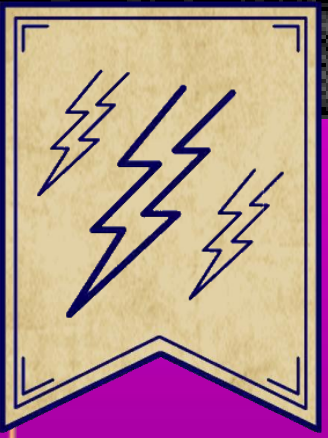




The clearer we see our need

Jesus' death, burial and resurrection

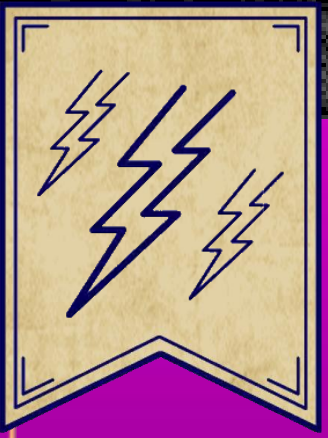
Zephaniah 1:1

to King Hezekiah



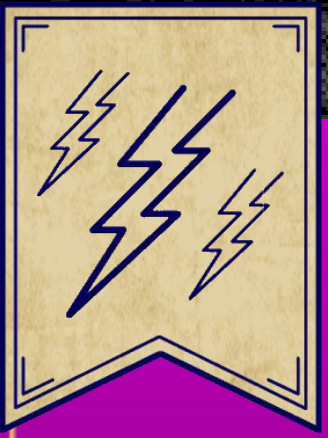


# Jesus is the only shelter in the Day of the Lord

Zephaniah 1:2-6



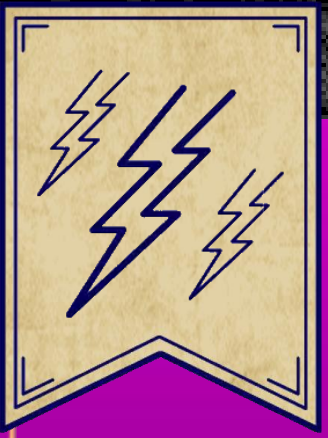




Good Godly heritage

it's Who we belong to

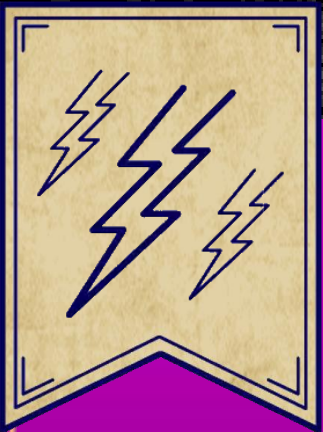
Zephaniah 1:7-13





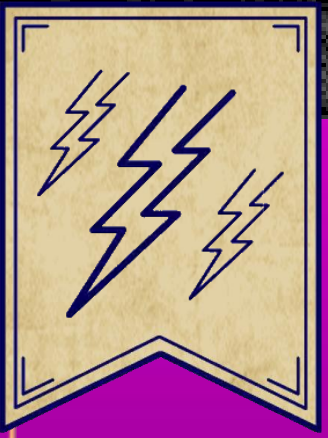
Coming face-to-face with

place where we reflect and repent





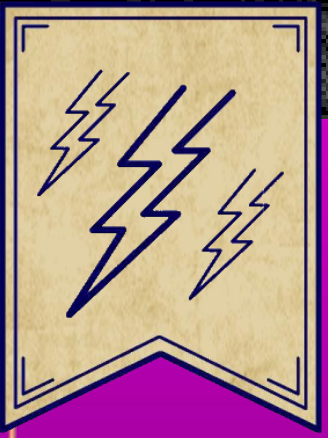
No protection is available for anyone-

means thickened or congealed



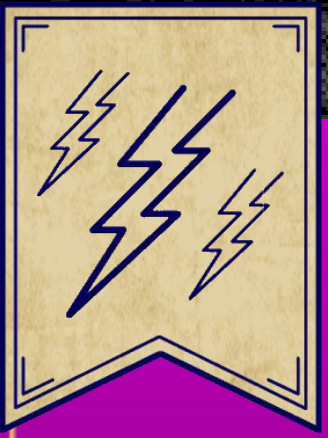


These are individuals whose
