In Micah 6 – we step into a courtroom scene: God the Perfect Judge states the charges against BOTH Israel and Judah





God directs their attention to
how wonderfully gracious He has been
to them throughout their existence
(God kept His end of the
covenant agreement)



Micah: The Messiah's Requirement





Micah 6:1-5

“Hear now” = a command to hear with attention and reverence and to act in humble obedience to what you hear





“Arise” = a call to action
(kind of like a bailiff’s call –
“All rise, court is now in session”)





Almighty God has a case against
His chosen and set apart nation –
before rattling off all of their offenses,
God directs them to how He
has upheld His end of the
conditional covenant





In each of the examples given,
God's great salvation is pictured

Micah 6:6-7





These people were so steeped
into depraved debauchery that
they DIDN'T see the depths of
their deception





The root problem is their
wayward heart and their complete
disregard and lack of obedience
to the One True God

Micah 6:8





God's requirement
was not hidden
it was told to them by God





Instead of acknowledging
this shortcoming and repenting –
they were unmoved and remained
in their prideful sin
