




Micah wanted the faithful remnant to remember the Messiah is coming

What Micah shared, personally impacted him – he was deeply distressed by Judah's denial and defiance against God




After looking around, Micah found that Godly men were few and far between

Watchmen were stationed ALL over the wall with the purpose of watching and then warning the city of coming danger






We DON'T live in the present without hope – our Messiah, our Deliverer and Rescuer, Jesus Christ is returning!
