Habakkuk has been nicknamed  
“The Questioning Prophet”

Habakkuk 1:1-4





Habakkuk's contemporary  
("The Weeping Prophet" = Jeremiah)  
is grieved over the heart level issues  
in Judah





# Habakkuk: What's My Response





Jeremiah 9:1-3

Judah had rejected God's truth  
(they had turned from God)

Jeremiah 9:4-6





Judah's turning away from truth  
and engaging in deceitful lying  
led to horrible consequences  
(refusing to know God)

II Chronicles 34:19-28





Hearing God's truth brought forth  
broken humility

II Chronicles 34:29-33





After being confronted by  
God's Word, Josiah submits, repents,  
and then publicly makes a change

I Corinthians 6:9-11







We might feel like we're 1,000 miles  
away from God, BUT we're ONLY  
1 step away from restoration





King Josiah saw an area  
that needed to be addressed and  
he humbled himself, repented and  
this response led to a revival

Jeremiah 36:20-26





Dissatisfied and unwilling to alter his lifestyle, Jehoiakim heard God's Word, cut up what he didn't like and threw it into the fire
