NOT about comfort, it's about Christ
(He alone is worthy to be exalted)





Habakkuk was confused and frustrated over what appeared to be God's silence regarding the wickedness of Judah





God had noticed the wickedness of Judah and God was now ready to address their adulterous heart issue

was rising up the Babylonians





There are 6 aspects of the
Babylonians emphasized:

1. They were ... Hostile

Habakkuk 1:6





“Fierce” = savage (like that of a wild animal, who is willing to attack anything that moves)

“Impetuous” = this speaks to the speed and efficiency with which the Babylonians deployed their troops
