"Why do you (God) appear to be silent?








Habakkuk 1:12-13

The pride of the Babylonians is being highlighted (what is bringing the Babylonians cause for rejoicing is their own ability and strength)

Until God answers, Habakkuk commits to waiting and watching



Habakkuk stands and stations himself, he is anchored at his location-NOTHING will move him; he's looking to God
