Habakkuk 2:1

From Habakkuk's watchtower,
he stands and stations himself in
complete confidence- he knows
God hears and will answer





Your sphere of influence
desperately needs what you claim to
believe- they need the Gospel

II Timothy 2:15





Habakkuk is anticipating an answer
that he plans on passing along to others
who have similar struggles





Habakkuk expectantly waits and is prepared to follow God regardless of how the Lord's answer might personally sting

Habakkuk has gone from watching his surroundings (the wickedness of Judah) to watching for the Lord





Habakkuk 2:2-3

What was recorded was to be SO large
and clear that even a person hurrying
by would be able to read it easily





“Run” = to act speedily;
to make haste; to swiftly dart

“Hastens” = (literally means = pants)
this is like a runner, sprinting as fast as
he can to the finish line (to the goal)





In God's perfect timing, His perfect
plan will be perfectly fulfilled
