Habakkuk: The Righteous Will Live By Faith





“Behold” = listen up;
give an attentive ear to
what’s about to follow

Habakkuk 2:4-5





These two verses present
a stark contrast between
the prideful Babylonians and
the righteous who live by faith





How is someone found
just or righteous before a
perfect and Holy God?





I. It's a righteousness that comes from God

“Righteousness” = a courtroom word meaning to declare NOT guilty; innocent of ALL charges





The **ONLY** hope for **ANY** of us,
because our own righteousness is
inadequate, is righteousness that
comes from another place





II. It's a righteousness from God received **ONLY** through faith

“Faith” = complete reliance upon another person to do what you are helpless to do for yourself





The contrast in Habakkuk 2:4-5
presents good news and bad news

Bad news = we have NO hope of
heaven outside of Jesus

Good news = those who put their
faith in Jesus are saved forever
