There's Hope... In Christ

Luke 24:1

These ladies left in a state of sorrow (they were mourning Jesus death and they were going to say their final goodbyes) Luke 24:2

The stone which covered Jesus' tomb had been rolled away

The stone was rolled away to let the witness IN (these witnesses needed to enter the tomb and see the truth)

Luke 24:3-7

"Perplexed" = they were filled with confusion

"Terrified" = they were extremely afraid

A dead Savior is a worthless Savior (that type of "savior" is utterly powerless and insufficient)

Because Jesus rose from the dead, everyone who believes in Him and follows Him will follow Him in resurrection as well

l Corinthians 15:20-24

Jesus' empty tomb is a beacon of tremendous hope (it assures ALL believers that our future tomb will ALSO be empty)

Luke 24:8-10 Luke 24:11-12

"Nonsense" = silly talk; totally devoid of anything worthwhile (they were skeptical and they didn't believe it)

Even though everything initially looked and felt absolutely hopeless-there was hope in Christ!
