John 6:1

"After these things" = NOT immediately after the events of Chapter 5, it's believed that between 6 to 12 months have passed

The Passover highlighted particularly God's provision for His people



Jesus first performs an undeniable sign miracle, reflecting a supernatural provision, which ONLY God can do and then Jesus connects the dots John 6:7-9

Philip is singled out because he was a **native of the nearby town of Bethsaida** and he would have been expected to know where to buy bread John 1:43-46

200 denarii took roughly 8 months of work to earn- even if they could get this large sum, the amount of food would never be sufficient in feeding this large crowd

ONLY AFTER the disciples were forced to confess their shortcomings and inadequacy at addressing this NEED does Jesus step in and take immediate action John 6:10-11

The typical practice in a Jewish family home was to give thanks both before and after partaking in the meal

John 6:12-14



This food made these people completely FULL and satisfied

John 6:15



NO earthly king or political leader was able to truly deliver ANYONE without Jesus' finished work on the cross
