


Part of the reason why Jesus hung on the cross for 3 hours was for this conversation with this criminal


God allowed this thief to get caught, convicted, and crucified (all of that led him to this conversion on the cross)


## Roman crucifixions could last up to 4 full days

Luke 23:40-43




1<sup>st</sup> Robber – mocked, ridiculed and verbally abused Jesus

2<sup>nd</sup> Robber – DIDN'T stay silent, he rebukes the 1<sup>st</sup> robber


"Rebukes" = written in the imperfect tense, which means this was an act done over and over and over again

## This thief's remorse led him to repentance


Luke 23:33-34a



Even unlearned and non-Jewish people were able to recognize Jesus was special and drastically different

This thief humbled by the weight of his personal guilt, STOPS making excuses and acknowledges the Supreme Authority of Jesus

Jesus promises this unworthy, filthy rotten sinner a FOREVER future with Him in eternity
