conversion on the cross)



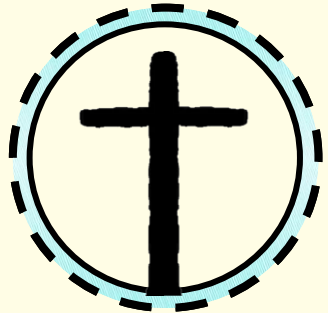
The THIEF ON the CROSS

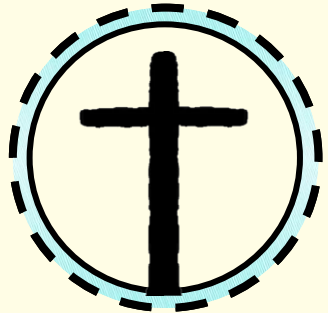
Roman crucifixions could last up

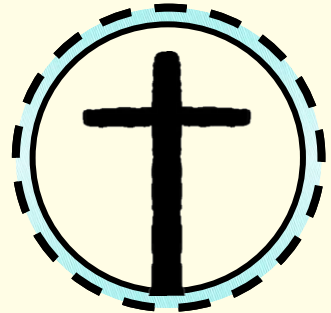


Understand EVERY detail of Jesus'

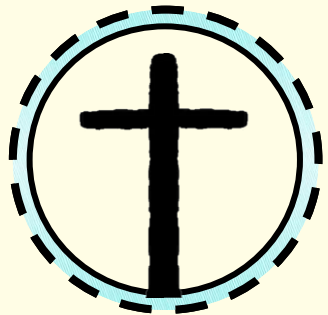

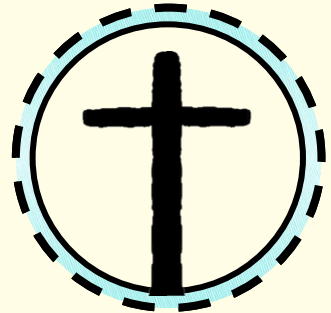

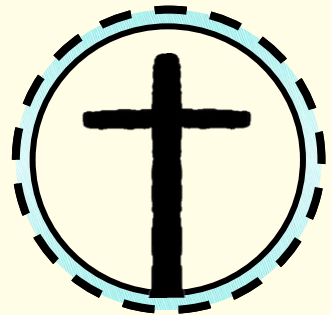
1st Robber – mocked, ridiculed

he rebukes the 1st robber



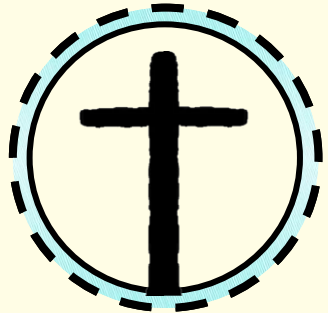

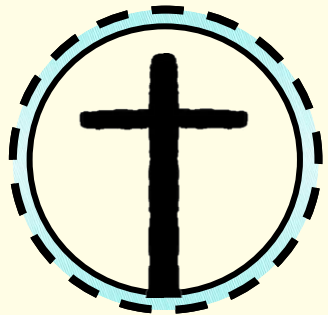


This thief's remorse led him to

Luke 23:33-34a

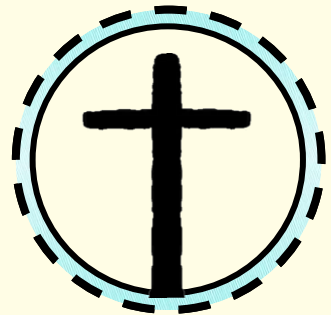


Even unlearned and non-Jewish
