Jesus identifies Himself to be the Eternal Light, which Genesis spoke of and the SAME Light of Glory shining in Revelation





THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

Before Jesus declares Himself to be the Light of the World, He exposes the gravity of sin of which everyone is guilty

John 8:1-11



The Pharisees had set what they thought was the perfect trap



Jesus simply broadens the scope and puts a spotlight on the dark corners and hidden recesses of everyone's heart John 8:12 John 8:13

Jesus' testimony was NOT ALONE (John 5:31–47)



Overwhelming evidence has been presented, but the Pharisees refused to see it and sought to reject Jesus

There was not a lack of evidence problem, there was a refusal and flat out denial problem when it came to Jesus of Nazareth

John 8:14-20



Jesus tells the Pharisees that even if His testimony was ALONE -He is the ONLY ONE qualified to make that claim

John 8:21-30



In the middle of this teachable moment, Jesus again draws the crowds attention to Who He is (He is the "I AM")
