"Abide" = to dwell; to remain attached as one; to be held and kept continually




In total satisfaction, we are able to abide in Christ (even though there are difficulties and hardships along our paths)

When Jesus declares "I AM ... The True Vine" He's inviting His disciples into an ongoing relationship, which is rooted in dependency

Every believer needs to live abiding in the true vine





THE VINE

John 15:1-3

"True" = Genuine; authentic; real



"Vinedresser" = one who plants, cares for, trims, and prunes the vine to ensure maximum and optimum fruitfulness

Every branch that has been engrafted into the vine has been meticulously cared for and attended to by God

Fruit only comes from when we are faithfully attached to the vine and then humbly submitted into the Father's tender hands John 15:4-7

"Abide" = to dwell; to remain attached as one; to be held and kept continually (this is a loving plea for us to stay connected)

When we're not abiding in Christ, then we're seeking satisfaction in something other than Christ as well
