awe and reverence before the Lord

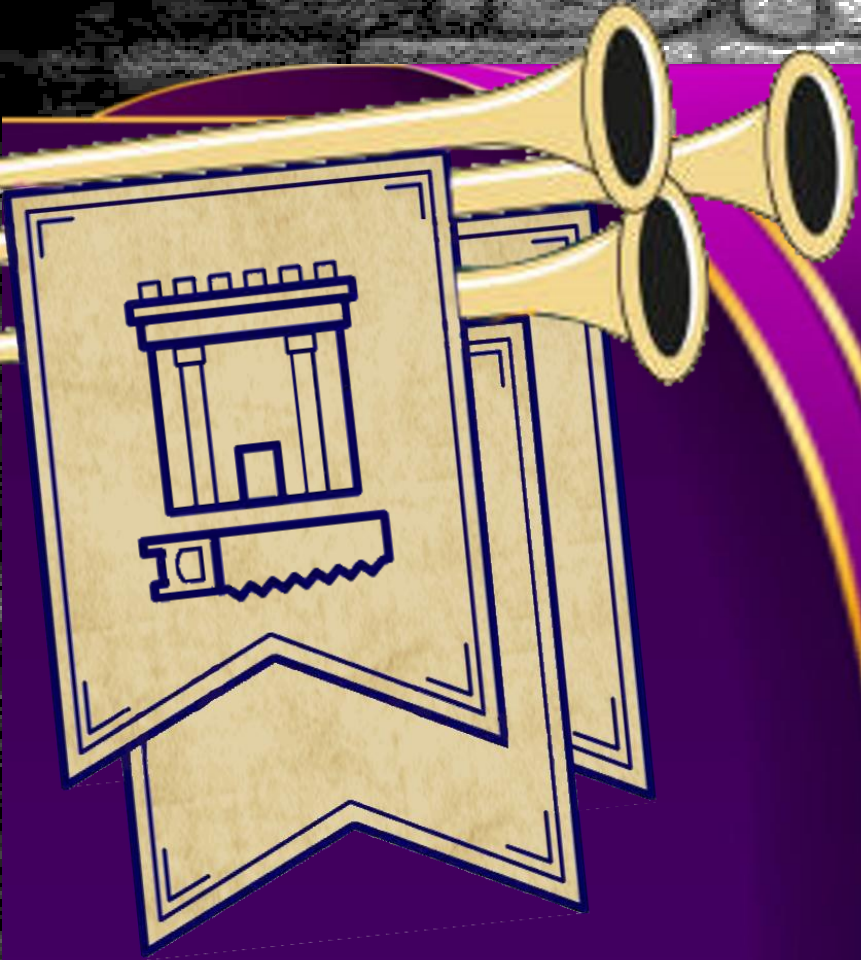




God's glory was no longer going to be isolated to a single location (on top of the Ark of the Covenant in Solomon's temple)



Haggai: Greater Glory To Come





Haggai 2 is God's response
to a discouraged and exhausted people,
who had just taken a step of faith
to obey God





Haggai 2 flashes the timeline
forward about 27 days





Revival begins with revering God, but how do we keep that fire and passion for God vibrantly burning within us?

Haggai 2:1-2





The God who commands humble
obedience is the **SAME** God who also
supplies the **NEEDED** strength

Haggai 2:3-9





God **DOESN'T** ignore their pain—
God acknowledges the struggle and
speaks hope into their discouragement





“Take Courage” = to restore to strength;
to be firm and secured;
be encouraged by





God gives a reminder of
His presence with His people





God's encouragement focuses
the people on the person of Jesus Christ
(the ONE who establishes peace
with God)
