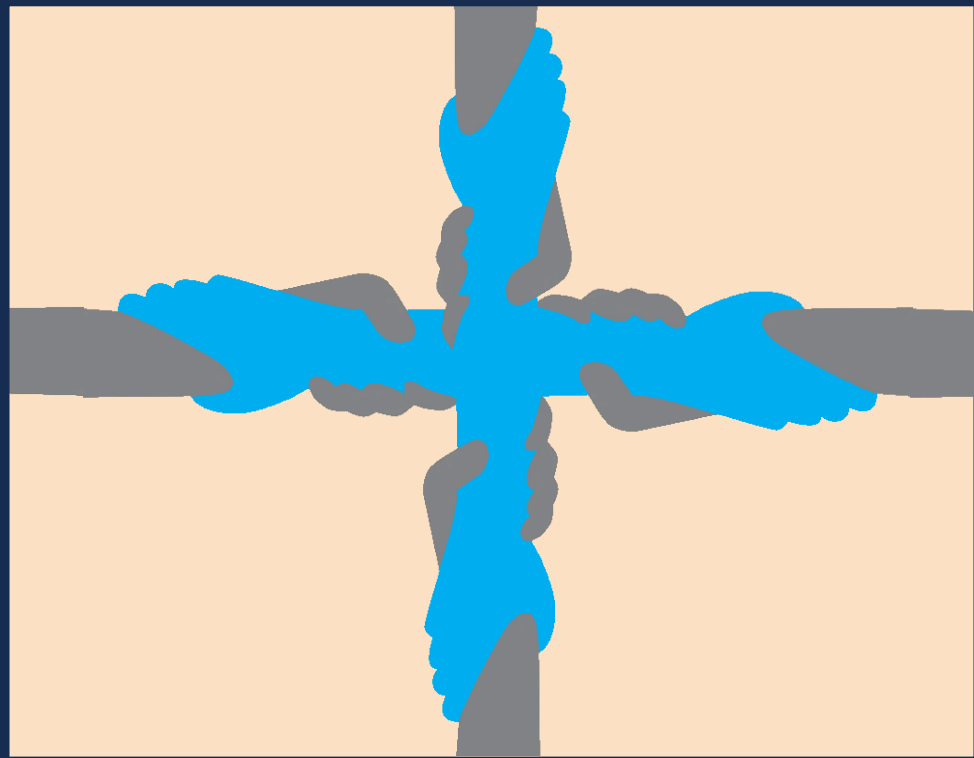

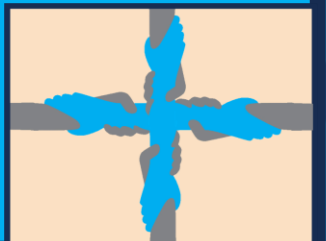
When it comes to our own sin,

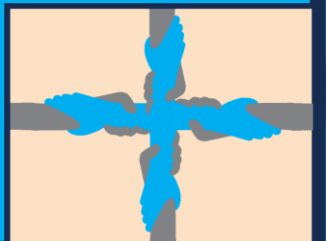

James 5:1-6

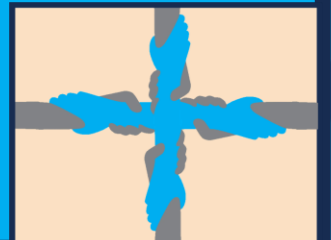
Any attempt to find our **security**

ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

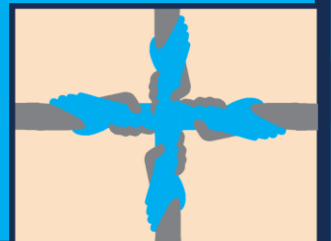
The road to **healing** begins

The **hope** which anchors each follower of Christ is firmly fixed to the certainty and confidence we have in the **return of Christ**



ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

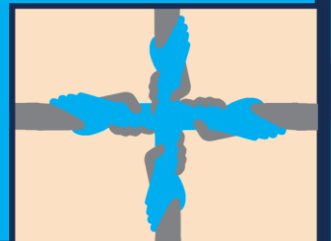
“Strengthen” = to set **firmly in place**
(like a foundation stone)

We should be **quick to confess sin**
because our Savior has already come
and on the cross He paid for
our sin **in full**

ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

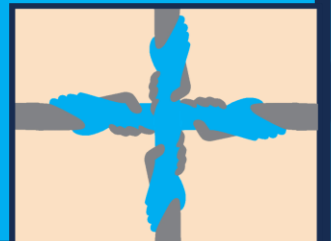
“Complain” = to groan from within;
to grumble inwardly

When we lose sight of God's **perfect timing**, we often revert to taking our **frustration** out on God's people

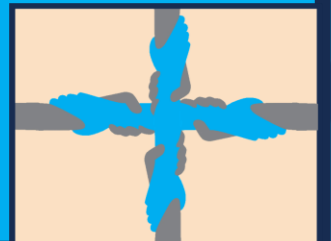
James 5:12

Attempting to **hide, justify, blame**, or speak half-truths reveals we don't agree with God about our sin

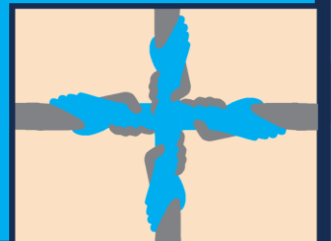
James 5:13-15
