ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

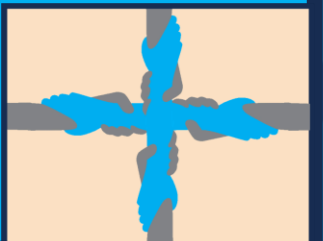
James 5:1-6

ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

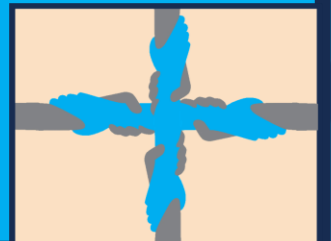
So, don't be deceived, **open your eyes**, don't drift from your first love

ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

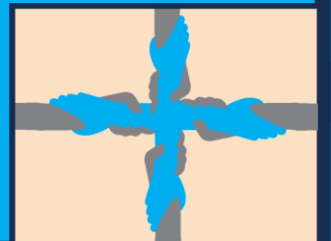
When our **dependency** on God

“Patient” – literally means to **endure under pressure** without **losing hope**; to remain steadfast despite facing personal difficulty



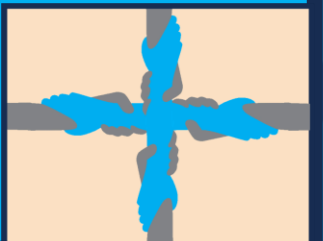
ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

Isaiah 40:31

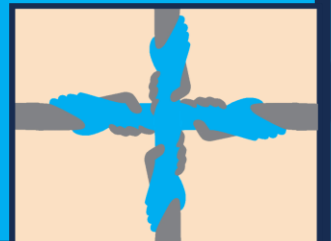
James 5:13-15

“**Pray**” = this type of prayer is deeper than merely physical healing

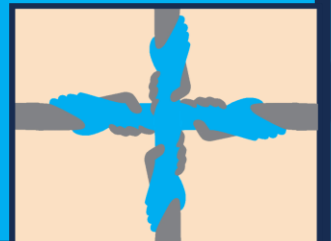
“**Suffering**” = it includes all forms of distress, trouble or trial

Our prayers of **intercession** are about engaging God on behalf of **another person** – in struggles, sharing life

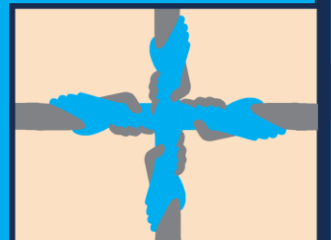
James 5:9-12



ONE ANOTHER: Following Jesus Together

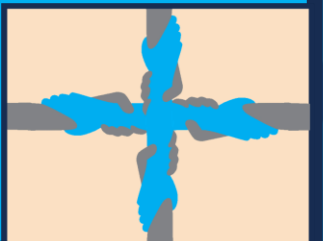
The **prophets** and **Job** faithfully
