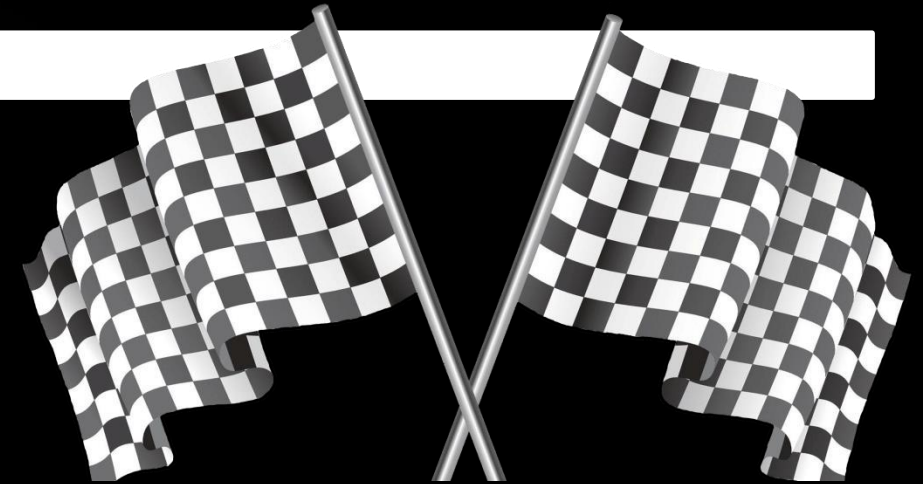

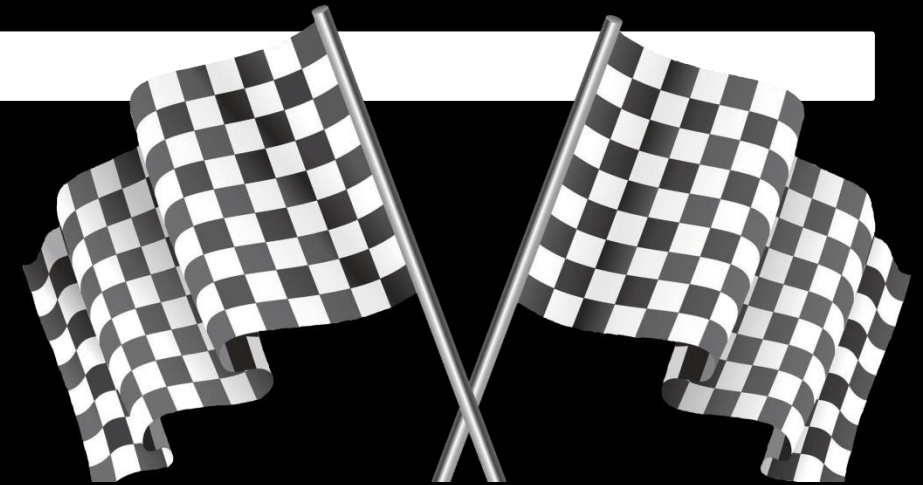


II Timothy 4:9-15

Paul names a few names
(some **good** & some **bad**):

I. **Demas**

Philemon 1:23-24;

Colossians 4:14;





II Timothy 4:10a

From my **fellow worker**; to
just mentioned (tacked on);
to having loved this present
world & has **deserted** me





DON'T be a **Demas**;
DON'T love **comfort**
MORE than **Christ!!!**





II. Cresans & Titus

Their purpose for leaving

Paul seems to be out of

necessity





III. **Luke** (the Gentile Doctor)
Apparently, while Paul sits
in a dark, damp, awful
prison – Luke is faithfully,
loyally **visiting** Paul





IV. **Mark**

John Mark **abandoned** the
work (temporarily) & Paul
had been **nervous** about
doing ministry with him again

II Timothy 4:11





John Mark (who was once a **deserter** – for maybe “justifiable reasons”) God got a hold of, **changed** him (& Paul’s attitude), so he’s now **useful**





v. **Tychicus**

II Timothy 4:12

Paul used **Tychicus** to deliver
3 of his letters (Ephesus,
Colossians, & Philemon)





VI. **Alexander** the **Coppersmith**

his associates

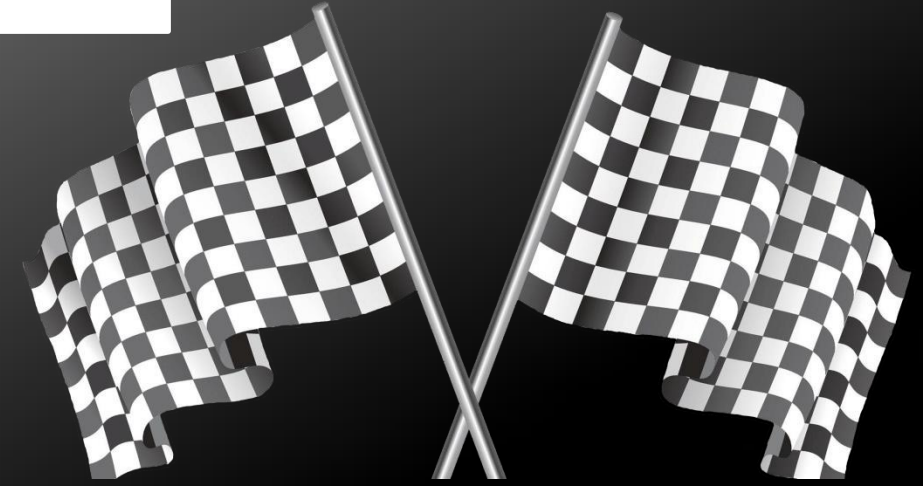
