Sermon Title: **“CHRIST: OUR SHELTER IN THE DAY OF THE LORD”**

Zephaniah 1:1-18

- Now everything that was originally \_\_\_\_\_ had been stained, corrupted, and broken because of \_\_\_\_\_ to rebel
- Everyone entered \_\_\_\_\_ and it still didn't rain until the \_\_\_ day
- God will once again judge sin in that coming day – called  
“ \_\_\_\_\_ ”
- The clearer we see \_\_\_\_\_ the more it magnifies \_\_\_\_\_ or the Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection
- Zephaniah is the descendant of \_\_\_\_\_ – able to be traced back to \_\_\_\_\_
- Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_ in the Day of the Lord
- Good \_\_\_\_\_ (having Godly ancestors) doesn't solve our problem – it's not about who we've \_\_\_\_\_ – it's Who we \_\_\_\_\_
- Coming face-to-face with the severity of the Day of the Lord ought to \_\_\_\_\_ and bring us to a place where we \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_
- No \_\_\_\_\_ is available for anyone- apart from the atoning \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice of Jesus Christ
- “ \_\_\_\_\_ in Spirit” = literally means thickened or congealed
  - These are individuals whose hearts are \_\_\_\_\_ (They've lost their sense of God's presence and power)
- This warning leaves NO room for \_\_\_\_\_ (the Day of the Lord is NOT an Optional Event – it is a \_\_\_\_\_)
