

Sermon Title: **“THE FALL OF JUDAH”**

II Chronicles 36:11-21

- It is so much better to learn from \_\_\_\_\_ mistakes, instead of experiencing those mistakes for \_\_\_\_\_
  - Judah should have \_\_\_\_\_ from their brother’s sin, unfortunately, Judah \_\_\_\_\_ in his brother’s footsteps
- Judah was really good at \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_ (they looked at their wayward sibling and were quick to recognize Israel’s sins)
  - As a whole, Judah \_\_\_\_\_ their own sin because they thought they weren’t \_\_\_\_\_ as their sibling
- Judah was a \_\_\_\_\_ to her sister’s treachery, but Judah didn’t learn from her sister’s \_\_\_\_\_
- “Evil” = this is \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ rebellion against God (This was not a mistake, it was an act of defiance)
- “Humble himself” = to \_\_\_\_\_; to be fully submitted (Zedekiah refused to respond by listening)
- Ezekiel 17 describes how Zedekiah disregarded a \_\_\_\_\_, which he swore by God to be faithful to King Nebuchadnezzar
- Instead of \_\_\_\_\_ to God, Zedekiah stiffened his neck and hardened his heart \_\_\_\_\_
- This \_\_\_\_\_ sin problem was from top down
