Haggai 1:1-11

- When you look at your \_\_\_\_\_ - How do you spend your \_\_\_\_\_ ?
  - What we \_\_\_\_\_ most is what we’ll spend our life \_\_\_\_\_ after
  - We can \_\_\_\_\_ look great – but if the heart behind everything isn’t focused on \_\_\_\_\_ and finding our satisfaction in Him alone then we’ve got a \_\_\_\_\_
- Sadly history shows that after laying the \_\_\_\_\_, the temple building project was stopped for about \_\_\_\_\_ (because of fear and getting comfortable)
- The temple remains unfinished and the only progress is the \_\_\_\_\_ which was built approximately \_\_\_\_\_ ago
