

Sermon Title: **“YOU’RE GONNA DO WHAT?”**

Habakkuk 1:14-2:1

- Have you ever wanted to know what your immediate \_\_\_\_\_ held?
- In light of the \_\_\_\_\_, Habakkuk wrestles with what appears to be a \_\_\_\_\_ to the Babylonians
- “Why do You (God) appear to be \_\_\_\_\_?”
- Babylon has been \_\_\_\_\_ the entire world – Judah is utterly helpless against Babylon and God’s silence seems to bring \_\_\_\_\_ into question
- The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Babylonians is being highlighted (what is bringing the Babylonians cause for rejoicing is their \_\_\_\_\_ and strength)
